Intermediate Climbing Camp 2008 Itinerary

Course Dates: July 20-28, 9 Days

This itinerary serves as an outline from which we structure the camp. It can change at anytime due to weather, students' needs and abilities, and interests.

This camp is designed to give the intermediate climber as much knowledge as possible about climbing and all that it entails. Safety, climbing commands, belaying, knots, harness and helmet use, body positioning and movement, face and crack climbing, hand jams, toe jams, rope care and management, use of protection, history of climbing and learning to second multi-pitch climbs will be covered in this course. Time is made for learning how to place protection and establishing belay anchors. Advanced climbing skills will be taught according to the skill level of the group.

This camp will be educational, stimulating, action packed and fun.

Day 1 July 20 – Students arrive at KMAC. Orientation. Equipment issue. Lunch and course overview. Afternoon ascent of Old Man Mountain. Bouldering in PM. KMAC climbs.

2. Other climbs in the Park

Day 6 – July 25 Deville Rocks Climbing movie

2. Deville 3 (II 5.8- R) 3 pitches

Day 7 – July 26 - Monastery: Many routes. **Other Options:** Hike in to camp at base of Elks Tooth. Ascend Elks Tooth (13,000feet) following day. Roped ridge climbing. Video. Mt. Evans. **Piz Badille: Multi Pitch.**

1. The Ridge (II 5.6) 6 short pitches
2. Right Side (II 5.7?) 4 pitches + simul climbing

Day 8 – July 27 Return to kmac. Celebration dinner. Showers, T-shirts. Begin closure. Paperwork, evals.

Day 9 – July 28: Final closure. Students depart kmac by 11:00am

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
